UNIVERSITY OF WAIKATO MASTERS STUDY AWARD

The Waikato Graduate Women Educational Trust offers annually to women students, who are enrolled fulltime at the University of Waikato for a thesis worth at least 90 points towards a Masters degree, an award of \$2000.

Closing date 30 April

Regulations for the award

- 1 The name of the Award shall be the Masters Study Award.
- 2. Applicants for the Award shall be women students who, at the time of application, are:
 - a) enrolled fulltime for a thesis worth at least 90 points for the Masters degree; and
 - b) holders of New Zealand citizenship or permanent residence for at least five years.
- 3. The Award shall be made, primarily, on academic merit.
- 4. Applications must be forwarded to the Awards Committee, P.O. Box 148, Hamilton.
- 5. Applicants shall provide:
 - a) a full academic transcript for all tertiary study, at both undergraduate and graduate levels, either as an original transcript or certified copy, **if your studies were not completed at the University of Waikato**;
 - b) a brief summary of the masters thesis topic (no more than one A4 side);
 - c) names and addresses of two academic referees whom the applicant has asked to provide a reference using the form provided with the Award application form. One referee must be the applicant's supervisor.
 - d) evidence of NZ citizenship or permanent residence.
- 6. The Awards Committee shall administer the Award. The Awards Committee shall include at least one member who is familiar with the departments within the University of Waikato and who has contacts with other universities.
- 7. If, in the opinion of the Committee, applicants are not of an acceptable standard, no Award shall be made.
- 8. Decisions made by the Awards Committee shall be final.
- 9. The number of awards shall be subject to:
 - a) availability of funds
 - b) standard of applicants.
- 11. The Award winners shall be announced in June of the year in which the applications are received.
