Waikato Graduate Women Educational Trust

Te Raranga Mātauranga Award

1. Purpose

To assist Māori women students enrolled full-time at the University of Waikato in the final year of a first undergraduate degree.

Each Faculty will be invited to nominate two candidates for the Award each year. The Award is not open to application from individual students who are not the nominees of their School or Faculty.

2. Funding available: \$1,000 per award.

3. Closing date: 30 April.

The Faculty must submit nominations, to the Waikato Graduate Women Awards Committee, P O Box 148, Hamilton 3240, by the due date, using the form provided on the Academic Awards page of the Waikato Graduate Women Educational Trust website.

4. Eligibility criteria

Nominees must be Māori women students:

- a) who are enrolled full time in the final year of their first Bachelor's degree in any School or Faculty of the University of Waikato; and
- b) who have included courses with some Māori content in their degree or, where the degree structure precludes Māori content, on the nomination of the Dean.

5. Nomination process

Nominations must include:

- a) A completed nomination form, signed by the Dean of the relevant Faculty;
- b) The signature of the nominee, agreeing to the nomination.

6. Selection

The Awards Committee of the Waikato Graduate Women Educational Trust will administer the Award. The Committee's decision is final.

The number of awards will be subject to availability of funds and the standard of nominations.

7. Awarding

Each Faculty and the successful nominees will be informed in June of the year in which the nominations are made.
